


### No. 0 TUBULAR.



THIS IS THE ACME OF PER-FECTION in the Tubular Lantern line, embodying improved features which exist in no other, and in appearance is one—the hardsomest Lanterns ever offered to be trade.

THE LITE. TO ICE does not simply roise the score for lighting, but also swings it out from between the tubes, thus leaving the way clear for filling the oil pot or trimming the wick. It is simplicity itself.

THE OIL POT is larger and holds 50 per cer. more oil than is usual in No. O Land rus. The bottom of the lander is double seamed to the oil pot, thus rendering leakage almost impossible. Each Lantern is carefully and before shipping.


HE SOLDERING JOBS on the Lander are only four in number, the rest of the word all being done by many, thus securing uniformity and reaight in every detail.



CHR ONE PIECE STAMPED TUBE is an entirely new feature, and has never before been used on a Tubular Lantern. Each side of the tube is made from one piece of tin, being joined at the edge by a seam. Heretofore this style of tube was made from six pieces, soldered together at the top. No solder whatever is used on our One Piece Stamped Tube.

THE GLOBE is easily removed by lifting the spring at the top of the I antern, when it is readily lifted out.




### No. 0 GLASS FOUNT.

This Lantern differs from our No. 0 Lantern, as described on Page 4, in the respect that it has a glass fount for an oil pot. This is remove ble, and the foot is so perforated, as shown in the cut, that the smount of oil remaining is easily seen. Leakage, as is evident, is rendered impossible.


